Approval of November Minutes-Phil LaSala provided the motion to approve the November minutes with Carisa Dillon to second the motion to approve. The minutes were then approved by a unanimous vote of the Board.

<u>Principal Report</u> (Christy Keenan provided a brief report on the following in Michaela Goerke's absence-Michaela will email additional information as needed, before the 2/14 SAB meeting)

- Technology Changes Upgrades to the infrastructure continues to be discussed.
 Discussions have also included talk to eliminate the computer lab and create a media
 center in the school library. This would require an additional Chrome Book and Cart
 purchase.
- **Terra Nova Results** Michaela and staff will be looking at the progression of test results over the last five years notating any areas in need of attention as well as areas we are progressing in.
- Accreditation & Parent Survey The NE Department of Education Frameworks External
 Team will make an accreditation visit to St. Gerald on 2/22. One of the accreditation
 requirements is to conduct a parent survey. This survey was sent out on 1/5. To date,
 102 or 270 families have participated. Accreditation also requires a parent panel to
 which Michaela may look to SAB to act as panel members.
- Parking Lot Challenges related to picking up and dropping off of students are still
 occurring. SAB suggested sending out another reminder on the procedures that were
 put in place at the beginning of the school year. SAB also suggested a "staggered"
 school dismissal on early dismissal days.
- Guided Reading Staff will attend the second Guided Reading professional development on 1/19. Christy and Michaela will attend the Administrators Only professional development in February. Hope is that Guided Reading "buy in" is achieved and gain knowledge on how to move forward with Guided Reading, the creating of book rooms, etc.

Other Items Christy will look into the inconsistency of lunch menus being sent out.
 Christy will also email Catholic Schools Week agenda and photos taken to Allison Balus for the church bulletin board.
